INFORMATION FOR DONORS

The UK Fund normally allocates the following amounts from Gift Aid tax reclaimed towards its administrative costs: 20% on donations up to £100; 10% on the next £9,900.00; 1% on the remainder over £10,000.00. If you are a UK taxpayer, regardless of residency or nationality, you can make your donation to the UK Fund under Gift Aid. The gift can be made in any currency. This means that the whole amount of the donation can be passed on to International Members. If there is no Gift Aid tax to reclaim, administrative costs will be deducted from the gift itself. Donations must be received by the 15th of the month preceding a quarterly Board Meeting in order for a grant based on your donation to be considered at that meeting. Board meetings will normally be held in January, April, July and October.
